Project Description

Comissioned by the City of Denver to construct the new Speer Boulevard Viaduct, Flatiron built a four-arch steel girder pedestrian bridge with six staircases and ramps for handicap use. The project also included the erection of a steel box girder railroad bridge and extensive landscaping.

The City of Denver celebrated the grand opening of this bridge during a gala grand opening in 1991.
